Delistage Process Three Times During Fermentation

**Winemaker Notes:**

Heavier crop loads and a very cool growing season allowed for some ideal extended hangtime. Perfect Fall weather gave way to even ripeness patiently brought in throughout the Valley. Fine tobacco leaf, Baker's Chocolate, and a brooding dark fruit profile form an intense nose. Racy acidity and balanced tannin to oak ratios support the jammy and refined fresh berry profile.
