TASTING NOTES:

A very expressive aromatic profile of ripe grapefruit, lichee, and hints of Yuzu peel. The palate reflects fresh melon, notes of pineapple and stone fruit. The acidity is perfectly balanced with the structural component lended by the Sur Lees aging technique.
