## Winemaker Notes:

Tamarind, plum, allspice and cedar notes encompass the aromatic profile. Bright cherry tart, tobacco leaf, and spicy tannins fill out the middle of the palate. The backbone is firm with integrated oak tannins that lengthen the finish.
