## Winemaker Notes:

The 2015 vintage yielded an extremely small crop that packed a big punch. Delicate tangerine oil, blossoms, and vanilla bean make up the aromatics. Copious amounts of tropical fruit greet the entry, the mid-palate shows hints of fresh cream, and a lingering textural finish is provided by the neutral wood fermentation.
