## Winemaker Notes:

Elements of Rainier cherries, red fruit jams, and notes of dark chocolate dust. The tannins are nicely integrated, not overbearing, and seamlessly lift the fruit on the palate providing a platform for a long finish. Approachable now and also cellar well for 10 to 15 years.
