Winemaking Notes:

Fresh blackberry, raspberry and vanilla bean leap out of the glass as the aromatics. Precisely integrated velvety tannins engulf a dark cherry fruit profile that finishes long. Good to drink Now and will cellar well for the next 15-25 years.
